

## CITY MANAGER'S WEEKLY UPDATE

### **THE MEADOWS**

The new owners of the Meadows Subdivision, near East Stockton Blvd. and Walnut Ave., submitted an application for revisions to the approved architectural plans. Changes to the architectural plan require Planning Commission approval. The Planning Department is working on the staff report for the March 14 Planning Commission meeting.

### **BICYCLE PARKING PROGRAM**

Planning staff partnered with Public Works staff to identify locations to install free bike parking racks offered by the Sacramento Metropolitan Air Quality Management District. The Air District's Bicycle Parking Program provides free bike parking racks and installation to cities in the region. Galt will receive a total of 24 free bike racks. The racks will be placed at the Galt Market, the MSC Building, the Sports Complex, Skate Park, along C Street and on Lincoln Way.

### **KING KONG TOOLS**

King Kong Tools is a tool distributor out of Germany and will be establishing a west coast hub to distribute and promote their product at 165 Enterprise Ct. They have an approved business license and submitted an application for a building permit on Monday, March 4. The tenant improvement plans include building office space and storage racking.

### **RECREATION UPDATE**

Children's Musical Theater – the class will begin on Thursday, March 7 and is full (30 students). The instructors have indicated that they are interested in offering a Summer Camp, possibly in July. Galt Gators and Swim Lesson registrations began on March 1. Lifeguard Training Class registration began on March 4 (limited to 10 students).
