LIVE OAK PUMP STATION AND FORCE MAIN PROJECT

The contractor (Marques Pipeline) has completed the placement of approx. 6,100 feet of force main piping and has poured the concrete foundation for the new pump station on Live Oak Ave. Pipe work along Twin Cities Road will occur over the next two weeks. Message boards are in place advising motorists of potential traffic delays.
