CONGRESSMAN MCNERNEY VISIT

Congressman McNerney visited with City staff as well as the Mayor and Vice Mayor this week to discuss items of importance to the City. We also provided him with a tour of the community. TWIN CITIES ROUNDABOUTS

Bid solicitation for the Twin Cities Roundabouts will be posted the week of April 1, 2013. Improvements will be on Twin Cities Road from Bergeron Road to West Stockton Blvd and will include the roundabouts along with pedestrian and bicycle improvements. Public Works anticipates publishing an addendum to the Roundabouts project to include the Twin Cities Road widening from Bergeron Road to east of Fermoy Way in the near future.

FIREARMS RECOGNITION

We have received an overwhelming response to the Firearms Recognition Class for school staff. PD personnel are continuing to plan this event.

RECREATION UPDATE

Positive Coaching Alliance - Staff has received donations in the amount of \$1,150 from the Galt Area Committee for Character in Sports/Galt Character Collation to schedule a third "Double Goal" coaches training session for some of the youth sport groups that use City of Galt facilities. The third class will be scheduled for late July or early August and will have coaches in attendance from the Jr. Warriors Football, Galt FC and County Line Youth Soccer. Staff has also extended an invitation to the Jr. Hawks Football and Torrascos Soccer.

Staff is currently working to finalize a contract for Zumba. The instructor plans to offer classes for adults and youth on Mondays and Wednesdays, parties for adults on Friday nights, and birthday parties for youth on the weekends. The current plan is to use the Littleton Community Center.

Art classes are scheduled to start on Monday, April 1. The Tuesday classes are full at 15 and there are 3 currently registered for the Monday class.
