

CITY MANAGER'S WEEKLY UPDATE

SMUD WORK

SMUD is installing new electrical conduits along Carol Drive north of Amador Avenue, on Delane Drive and other streets in that subdivision.

AT&T WORK

Contractors for AT&T will be installing a new U-verse cabinet along New Hope Road, just west of the intersection with Spur Way.

COUNCIL CHAMBER IMPROVEMENTS

Staff is seeking quotes for improvements in the Council Chambers including repainting, removing wood paneling and other visual improvements. An RFP for a new sound system in the Chambers was also issued this week. The work is being funded by PEG fees from the Metro Cable Commission.

BAR NONE AUCTION

Staff met with the owner of Bar None Auction this week to review the recently submitted site plan for the relocation of Bar None Auction from Sacramento to Galt at the Calstone block location on Crystal Way. Bar None Auction sells used heavy equipment and machinery. They hope to be operational this summer.

MCLAUGHLIN WASTE EQUIPMENT

Staff met this week with the owners of McLaughlin Waste Equipment about locating their manufacturing business which fabricates new waste containers and related parts to a portion of the building purchased by Cal Waste in the Industrial Park. They intend to occupy an approximate 25,000 ft space currently occupied by Nor Cal Beverage. McLaughlin plans on employing up to 15 people initially and could eventually expand to 50. It will require a Conditional Use Permit that is expected to be considered by the Planning Commission in June.
