

CITY MANAGER'S WEEKLY UPDATE

June 7, 2013

LIVE OAK PUMP STATION AND FORCE MAIN

Force main construction on Live Oak Avenue west of McFarland Street is scheduled for this week. This will necessitate a road closure to all but local traffic. Construction on Live Oak Avenue is expected to take two weeks to complete.

TWIN CITIES ROAD CONSTRUCTION

Unrelated to the Live Oak Pump Station and Force Main Project, County crews will be replacing a failed culvert on Twin Cities Road. The County will shut down Twin Cities Road east and west of the UPRR crossing on June 11 and June 12 for this work. This failed culvert was discovered during construction of the City's sewer force main.

FIBER OPTIC LINE INSTALLATION PROJECT

The contractor (Terry Hansen Electric) began installation of conduit for the fiber optic line project this past week. Approximately 1500 of the total 7500 linear feet of 3" conduit have been installed on Industrial Drive and Elm Avenue. The remaining conduit installation work is expected to be complete by the middle of July, and the pull boxes, fiber optic cable line installation, and data connection work is expected to be complete by end of July.

WALKER COMMUNITY PARK

The playground out at Walker Community Park was featured in the 2013 catalog for Playworld Systems, the manufacturer of the playground equipment.

5K TONN RUN

Staff and event organizers met with Parks and Rec to plan the route and work out details for the event. To date, 167 participants are registered.

GRAB EM

A representative from the Sacramento County Sheriff's Office, CAL ID Unit, Regional Support Team, demonstrated the "GRAB EM" hand held identification device to police staff on Wednesday. This mechanism allows officers to print and identify subjects in the field. The Sheriff's Office was awarded a grant for this program and has offered to include the Galt Police Department in the project. The MOU for such a collaboration is under review.

RECREATION UPDATE

The SOAR Program will take place at River Oaks Elementary School beginning June 10 for 10 weeks. Five participants are currently registered.

City Tots graduation for the 2012/2013 classes was held on Wednesday at the Littleton Center. Registration is open for the 2013/2014 school year.
