### **JOINT USE AGREEMENT**

The Galt Elementary School District unanimously approved the Joint Use Agreement with the City at a special meeting on June 13. The Agreement will go into effect on July 1.

### **COMPREHENSIVE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT STRATEGY COMMITTEE MEETING**

The second CEDS Committee meeting was held on June 13 to review the feedback and strategic objectives discussed at the first meeting and to begin the process of prioritizing the initiatives and action items. The consultant is in the process of preparing the draft document for public review in July.

### **MCLAUGHLIN WASTE EQUIPMENT, INC. CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT (CUP)**

The Planning Commission approved a Conditional Use Permit CUP for McLaughlin Waste Equipment, Inc on June 13. McLaughlin Waste Equipment manufactures metal waste containers and roll off boxes. The company is proposing to operate the business at 175 Enterprise Ct, Suite C, in the City's Industrial Park. McLaughlin Waste Equipment plans to hire between 10-15 employees.

### **POLICE ACTIVITY**

On Thursday, June 13, members of the police department gave a presentation on the dangers of prescription drugs and how they can impact the youth of Galt.

Galt's Parrot Cellular was the victim of an armed robbery by unknown suspects who may have been involved in similar robberies in other cities. The Crime Prevention Coordinator will be contacting Parrot Cellular regarding crime prevention measures that may assist in reducing their vulnerability.
