

## CITY MANAGER'S WEEKLY UPDATE

June 21, 2013

### **FIBER OPTIC LINE INSTALLATION PROJECT**

The contractor is about 65% complete with conduit installation work. This past week conduit work on Lincoln Way was accomplished. Staff expects the final conduit work, along C Street from Lincoln Way to City Hall, to be completed prior to the 4th of July weekend.

### **LIVE OAK PUMP STATION AND FORCE MAIN**

The contractor is continuing to install pipe along Live Oak Avenue. The road is closed to all but local traffic. The pipeline work at this location is expected to be completed in the next week.

### **E STREET LIFT STATION**

Falco Construction will start mobilizing for Phase I work next week for the E Street Lift Station. Phase I work will install facilities to temporarily by-pass sewer flow and isolate the existing sewer well. The contractor will enter the 24 feet deep well, obtain field measurements, and send the information to the wet well liner fabricator. The Phase I work is anticipated to be completed within a couple of weeks.

### **CODE ENFORCEMENT**

Two vacant properties on the west side of town have been abated of high dry weeds, a substandard house on Oak Avenue has been restored with properly secured windows, water service and electrical. Galt Plaza pigeon netting issue was addressed and the owner is working on a better solution.

### **KING KONG TOOLS**

Plans were approved and a tenant improvement (office space and storage racking) permit was issued to King Kong Tools – 165 Enterprise Court. The company is a tool distributor out of Germany and will be establishing a west coast hub to distribute and promote their products.

### **LAW ENFORCEMENT GRANTS**

Staff submitted the extension request for the COPS Hiring Grant and received approval allowing an additional eight months to use the grant funds. Staff submitted an application for a new grant offered by the COPS program that focuses on School Resource Officers. If approved, Galt would have two School Resource Officers.

### **GORA AQUATIC CENTER**

We had significant tile failure at the zero entry pool at the Aquatic Center on Thursday. Parks Maintenance will be performing drain and tile repairs that will require the small pool including the two water slides to be closed through Friday, June 28<sup>th</sup>. Swim lessons will be accommodated in the larger pool.
