SACOG GRANT FUNDING

SACOG recently issued a call for project applications for Bike / Pedestrian grant funding. Staff submitted an application on August 16 for approximately \$270,000 of funding. The project application included:

Bike Lanes

- New Hope Rd, city limits to First St
- West Elm Ave, city limits to McFarland Rd
- Kost Rd, city limits to Raven Brook Dr

Bike Routes

- Emerald Oak Dr, West Elm Ave to West A St
- Fumasi Dr, West A St to West C St
- Sparrow Dr, West Elm Ave to West A St
- West C St, Fumasi Dr to Fourth St
- First St, New Hope Rd to Kost Rd

GOLDEN HEIGHTS WTP

On Wednesday, the Golden Heights Deep Well failed. Golden Heights provided over 30 percent of the City's water in July 2013. As the project has not been accepted, the contractor is fully responsible to replace all failed equipment. The Contractor is currently removing all equipment in the well to determine the cause of the failure and then will replace the faulty equipment. Until the well is repaired, water users in the northeast area more experience low pressures.

TWIN CITIES ROUNDABOUTS

The City held a groundbreaking ceremony for the Twin Cities Roundabouts project on Friday August 16. The first order of work is utility relocations followed by roadwork in the northwest quadrant of the interchange. Notifications about upcoming closures and detours will be posted on the City's website and in the local papers as date and locations are confirmed.
