

CITY MANAGER'S WEEKLY UPDATE

WILTON RANCHERIA PUBLIC SCOPING MEETING

The Bureau of Indian Affairs conducted a public scoping meeting this week as the first step in the environmental review process for the proposed Wilton Rancheria Casino project proposed to be constructed just north of the Galt City limits, west of highway 99 and north of Twin Cities Road. The next opportunity for public comment will be after the draft environmental impact statement is released later next year.

PARKS MAINTENANCE

Staff has begun annual ball field maintenance in preparation for the coming season. Staff is tilling and leveling the infields; outfields will be rolled. Pitching mounds and batters boxes will be rebuilt as needed.

WATER DISTRIBUTION

Staff repaired a leaking six-inch water main at the intersection of Church and G streets. There were five new water service leaks reported last week. Staff replaced two services and will be replacing the remaining leaking services in order of priority.

TWIN CITIES ROUNDABOUTS

The contractor will be moving forward with tree removal and fence relocations required within and adjacent to the East Stockton Park and Ride Lot, south of Twin Cities Road. To safely remove these trees, the Park and Ride will be closed December 26 – 30, and will reopen on December 31.

WATER METER PROJECT

Global Water completed installation of 5 data collection units, and 18 water meter transmitter units at designated locations throughout the City. Global has started testing to ensure the collectors and transmitters are synchronizing with the software.
