### **OFFICER KEVIN TONN**

The City held a one year remembrance ceremony in honor of the life and sacrifice of Officer Kevin Tonn, who was killed in the line of duty one year ago, on January 15, 2013.

### **LIVE OAK PUMP STATION**

The week of January 20, the contractor will be coating the inside of several manholes along Live Oak Avenue between McFarland Avenue and the pump station. Traffic control will be in place during construction, and traffic delays should be minimal.

### **JAYCEE HALL DEMOLITION**

The contractor has begun abatement of the building exterior which should be completed by the end of this week. Demolition of the structure is anticipated to start next week and be completed by the end of the week.

### **FAMILY DOLLAR STORE**

The contractor has demolished the old restaurant building at the corner of Lincoln and A Street. Next week, site demolition will be completed, to be followed by initiation of store construction.
