ADULT MENS' AND CO-ED SOFTBALL LEAGUE

“LOCAL RULES”

**Are in addition to those adhered to by the
National Governing Body of “A.S.A. – Amateur Softball Association”**

SEEDING

Seeding will be determined by overall record. In the event of a tie with two or more teams, the following tie breakers will be used to determine seeding.

Tie breakers:

1. Head to Head
2. Total Runs Allowed
3. Coin Flip

PROTESTS

Protests may only be made by registered manager. The manager will immediately notify the scorekeeper of the protest and continue the game. The registered manager then must submit in writing within 24 hours (or the next business day) of the game in question a letter of protest to the Recreation Supervisor. **(A JUDGEMENT CALL CANNOT BE PROTESTED).**

Acceptable ways of submitting protests are as follows:

1. Deliver to the Parks and Recreation office during regular business hours of 8:00a.m. – 5:30p.m., Monday through Thursday.

RULES

1. Use of Non-Approved Bats will result in the players' immediate ejection. His or her position in the batting line up will count as an out for the remainder of the game.
2. 10 run rule after 5 innings. Teams may continue to play with a drop dead rule of 55 minutes.
3. Home Runs: Upper 2 with equalizer up to 5
 Lower 2 with equalizer up to 3
Rec Home runs will result in an out.
4. 55 minute time limit. No new inning shall begin after 55 minutes. Games may end in a tie. This is to insure that all games start as close to their scheduled times.
5. Legal pitched balls that touch the plate and/or mat upon landing are strikes.
6. Courtesy Runner: Men's One (1) per inning (last out)
 Co-ed One (1) per male and one (1) female per inning (last out)
7. All batters will start with a 1 & 1 count.
8. Must have 7 players off current roster to start a game. If a “pick up player” is used and protested by the opposing team before the start of the second inning, the game will be forfeited by the team using the “pick up player”. The game may still be played.
9. Players may only be added to the roster before the 5th game is played in an 8 game season. Players may only be added at the Parks and Recreation Department during regular business hours.
10. Players are not permitted to play for 2 teams in the same division.
11. No metal spike will be allowed.
12. Unlimited batting line-up.
