

## CITY MANAGER'S WEEKLY UPDATE

### **HERBICIDE SPRAYING**

Staff resumed city-wide herbicide spraying to eradicate weed growth on vacant City-owned properties and public right-of-ways. Staff also applied a broadleaf inhibitor to the natural turf fields at Walker Park to eliminate undesirable grass and weeds from the hybrid Bermuda turf.

### **TWIN CITIES ROUNDABOUTS AND WIDENING**

Full scale construction resumed this past week on the East Stockton Blvd. roundabout and roadway approaches. Detours are in place for Northbound Hwy 99 on and off-ramps from East Stockton Blvd.

### **TEMPORARY PARK AND RIDE**

Staff installed signs at the Temporary Park and Ride, which is located between Rite Aid and Subway. Staff installed one directional sign on Twin Cities Road to direct commuters to the Temporary Park and Ride lot.

### **SCHOOL BUS SAFETY TRAINING**

The Police Department provided training to 100 school bus drivers from Galt and surrounding areas in the area of gun awareness and safety. The class which was 4 hours in length, was well received. The department continues to build ongoing relationship with our school partners by providing appropriate and needed training. Additional training's with the schools will occur on an as-needed basis.
