TWIN CITIES ROUNDABOUTS AND WIDENING

Construction is continuing on the Twin Cities Roundabouts project. The contractor will be working during the week from 7:00 am to 7:30 pm and on some Saturdays from 7:30 am to 3:30 pm in order to be substantially complete by June 1, 2014. Detours are in place for Northbound Hwy 99 on and off-ramps from East Stockton Blvd.

MEASURE A

Staff presented an overview of the current Measure 'A' transportation program and proposed future expenditure plan at the Galt Chamber of Commerce luncheon on March 20. This is part of an ongoing outreach program to identify community priorities for future expenditure plans and levels of support for enhanced transportation funding.
