

## CITY MANAGER'S WEEKLY UPDATE

### **CENTRAL GALT INTERCHANGE LANDSCAPING**

The landscaping for the Central Galt Interchange is currently out to bid, with April 17<sup>th</sup> as the bid opening date. It is anticipated the construction contract will be brought to City Council for approval at the May 2<sup>nd</sup> meeting. The landscaping will provide a variety of trees, plants and ground cover to mitigate the impacts of removing vegetation as part of the interchange construction.

### **WATER METER INSTALLATION PROJECT**

Global (Fathom) has started field audit work which includes recording parameters (water meter numbers, sizes, boxes, lids, etc.), and comparing against existing parcel/billing records. Digital photographs will be included in the documentation. The field audit work is anticipated for completion in May, followed by the start of meter installation in June.

### **CITY HALL LANDSCAPING**

Maintenance staff has begun the processing of removing old vegetation adjacent to the entryway to City Hall in preparation for new landscaping.
