LINCOLN WAY AND A STREET TRAFFIC SIGNAL

Repairs to the signal detection loop and return to automatic timing have been completed.

AMADOR AVE / LINCOLN WAY TRAFFIC SIGNAL

Due to the Twin Cities detour being routed through the intersection of Amador Ave./Lincoln Way, this intersection has experienced a significant increase in traffic. Specifically, the movements of southbound Lincoln Way to westbound Amador Ave. and eastbound Amador Ave. to northbound Lincoln Way have been impacted. To help ease the traffic congestion at this intersection, the signal timing has been changed to increase the green time for both of these movements.

TWIN CITIES ROAD CLOSURE

Twin Cities Road remains closed to through traffic between the railroad tracks west of Hwy 99 and Casity Lane east of Hwy 99, along with the on and off ramps to Hwy 99. The night closures on Twin Cities Road from Fermoy Way to McKenzie Road are completed. The work was completed on the nights of April 23 and 24, making the night closures for April 25 and 28 unnecessary.

CDD UPDATE

Plans for the CVS' tenant improvement project were submitted into plan check and staff completed final inspections of five homes in River Oaks (Elliott).
