TWIN CITIES ROUNDABOUTS / WIDENING

The Twin Cities Roundabouts and Highway 99 overpass and ramps are scheduled to be re-opened to public traffic on June 2nd. Additional work will continue on the roundabout sculptures, glass mulch, and artificial turf and landscaping adjacent to the roadway shoulders. Concurrent with the opening of the roundabouts, Fermoy Way, from Twin Cities Road to the Raley's shopping center driveway, will be closed for 4 to 6 days to facilitate the safe completion of the traffic signals at the Fermoy intersection. Access will be maintained to all businesses on Twin Cities.
