

CITY MANAGER'S WEEKLY UPDATE

May 23, 2014

HARVEY PARK

The Beautification Committee volunteers are continuing work on the northeast corner of the park. They planted and spread bark in the planter areas and worked on leveling the walking path. Staff has been working closely with the volunteers to make sure they have the necessary materials.

TRIP HAZARD REMOVAL

Trip hazards, caused by tree roots uplifting sidewalks, are being removed on Fourth Street, at the Aquatic Center, and the Library.

AQUATIC CENTER

The re-tile of the recreation pool was completed just in time for the summer opening. Staff is preparing the pool for opening. Staff began dismantling the small water slide last Thursday. Final work will continue this week, with staff working around scheduled events and daily pool openings at noon.

ACTIVE TRANSPORTATION PROGRAM FUNDS

The City has applied to the State for Active Transportation Program (ATP) funding. The proposed project consists of pedestrian, bicycle and ADA improvements around Greer Elementary School, Valley Oaks Elementary School and Galt High School. The City has requested \$1.8 million for construction. Project selection by the state is anticipated to be completed by September 2014. If the City's application is not selected at the state level, the proposed project will compete at the regional level through SACOG. Regional project selection is anticipated to be completed by December 2014.

VINTAGE OAK LIFT STATION REHABILITATION

The project was advertised for bids on Tuesday, May 20th, with the bid opening scheduled for Thursday, June 26th. This project will establish a temporary by-pass system for pumping sewage from the City's northeast area to the Wastewater Treatment Plant. Then the existing lift station will be cleaned and re-lined, with new pump rails installed.

NEW HOME DEVELOPMENT

Elliot Homes was issued the remaining 10 SFD permits for Woodbury Estates (River Oaks)
