CITY MANAGER'S WEEKLY UPDATE August 1, 2014

OFFICER KEVIN TONN MEMORIAL

The City has hired Omni Means to finalize the design and prepare the construction documents for the Tonn Memorial at City Hall. A meeting was held this week with the design engineer, staff, members of the ad hoc committee and CHAMP representatives to discuss design preferences and alternatives based on the available budget. Work is proceeding quickly with the goal of having the monument installed by January 15, 2015.

2014 PAVEMENT PROJECT

Staff conducted a pre-construction meeting to discuss details of work this past week. The project scope of work includes base repair, micro-surfacing, and overlay work. The project overlay locations are portions of E. Stockton, Pringle, Amador and 4th Street; the micro-surfacing locations are segments of Caroline, 5th Street and D Street. C Street near Valley Oaks Elementary School will receive extensive base repairs. Construction will begin the second week of August and will be completed by the end of September.

WATER METER PROJECT

Starting the first week of August, the City's contractor will begin to distribute notices and install water meters. Properties that have previously paid water a meter installation fee will have their meters installed first. The contractor will continue water meter installation on remaining properties city-wide thru February 2015.

STAGE 2 – WATER ALERT

Effective August 1st, new restrictions have been placed on outdoor water use. These include limiting watering to three days per week, prohibiting washing hardscapes, and requiring automatic shut-off devices on hoses. A complete listing of restrictions and penalties is listed on the City's website.

FAMILY DOLLAR

The developer continues work on the site, with landscaping installation beginning to take place, in order to meet the projected August 21 opening date.
