AB 2493 REDEVELOPMENT BONDS

AB 2493 was approved by the Senate Appropriations Committee this week and is expected to be voted on the Senate floor as early as next week. If approved by the Senate and then signed by the Governor, the City would be able to proceed with its planned Old Town revitalization projects.

VIEWU BODY WORN CAMERAS

NCCSIF Police Risk Management Committee meeting, voted to purchase 66 Viewu body worn cameras for the members of the JPA. The department is developing a policy to address their use, sign out system, storage of data and several other issues. We anticipate their arrival the last week of August.
