

CITY MANAGER'S WEEKLY UPDATE

EDUCATION SUMMIT

The City and school districts hosted the second Education Summit at Brewster's on November 6. The event was well attended and included youth participants this year. The purpose of the Summit was to celebrate and learn how the City of Galt, Galt High School District and Galt Elementary School District used 2013 Summit ideas and feedback for educational progress and provide new ideas and feedback that supports the goal of every student graduating ready for college, career and life.

2014 WELL REHABILITATION PROJECT

The project is nearing completion. A total of four wells have been rehabilitated (Gateway, River Oaks, Golden Heights, and Fumasi).

WATER METER PROJECT

The contractor has installed over 2,600 new water meters to date, and will soon activate these meters to allow testing of the radio-read data collection system. A majority of the meters have been installed in the northeast areas of the City. The contractor is working to finish the remaining meter installations in the northeast areas and will move to the west areas of the City next week. Invoices for water meter charges will be mailed out next week to those residents who have not previously paid a water meter deposit.

COMBINED HIGH SCHOOL VOLUNTEER PROJECT

Approximately 100 students from Galt and Liberty Ranch High Schools spent two hours at the locations listed below. This was a team building project for the two schools. The City supplied the materials and the school district supplied the tools necessary to complete the tasks. Becca Dennis organized the project for the School District and was instrumental in making this a huge success.

Old Town/Lincoln Way

- Sweep sidewalks and store fronts
- Trash/litter pick up
- Sweep/pick-up debris out of street gutters
- Weed removal in any of the planter boxes/shrub beds

Harvey Park

- Paint picnic tables
- Clean trash can lids and paint
- Paint BBQ's
- Paint score keepers stand
- Paint restroom and concession stand doors
- Clean/wash down bleachers
- Trash/litter removal

Canyon Creek Park

- Paint bollards (4)
- Paint trash can receptacles (5)
- Paint benches (10)
- Paint picnic tables (7)

- Trash/litter/weed removal

Community Park

- Pavilion clean up – remove old tape from pavilion structure/ tables, wipe tables clean
- Picnic/BBQ areas – wipe tables clean, remove old tape from under tables
- Trash/litter/weed removal throughout the park
- Wipe clean natural trail signs
- Level dirt out in horse shoe pits and clean up area
