

CITY MANAGER'S WEEKLY UPDATE

STREETLIGHT MAINTENANCE UPDATE

The City received notification this week that SMUD will be conducting a comprehensive survey of areas identified by the City with street light maintenance problems, including rust. A map of the affected areas is attached.

SMUD has indicated that they are committed to completing the survey in January and repairing or replacing all affected poles by the end of the 1st quarter 2015, dependent on weather. The replacement poles use newer fiberglass material that will not be subject to the same rust issues.

SIMMERHORN-CARILLION WATER MAIN PROJECT

The contractor has completed pressure testing and disinfection of the water main. Connection to the west end of Simmerhorn Road has been completed. To connect to the Vauxhall/Carillion intersection, water service to the Chancellor Estates subdivisions must be temporarily interrupted. On Thursday, December 4, advisory notices were delivered to affected customers. The work is scheduled for **Tuesday, December 9 between the hours of 9:00 A.M. to 3:30 P.M.**

VINTAGE OAK LIFT STATION PROJECT

The Contractor has scheduled construction of temporary sewer bypass piping during the week of December 8, weather permitting. Lane closures and traffic controls will be in place during active construction within the roadway. Construction activities within the roadway will be limited during early morning and afternoon hours to minimize conflicts with school traffic.

WATER METER INSTALLATION PROJECT UPDATE

Over 3,300 water meters have been installed to date. The contractor is currently working in the Lapwing Lane, Spoonbill Lane, Elm Avenue, and Ashley Way areas. Weather permitting, water meter installation will continue in the Quail Hollow area the following week.

EBT PROGRAM AT GALT MARKET

EBT Program was slated to start this week and EBT booth staff were at the Market both Tuesday and Wednesday mornings, but due to the weather our first week was rained out. EBT contract staff was able to contact a few vendors they did not speak to on November 26 when they visited the market for signups, and have now signed up approximately 50% of the produce vendor to accept EBT. Staff is looking forward to being able to kick this program off next week under better weather conditions.

CO-ED SOFTBALL

Due to the holidays and the last few weeks of rain, the 2nd half of the Co-Ed Softball season has been cancelled. Teams will receive a refund of \$180 or a credit of \$200 towards the 2015 season.
