OFFICER KEVIN TONN MEMORIAL DEDICATION

Several hundred people attended the dedication this week of the Officer Kevin Tonn Fallen Heroes Memorial and unveiling of the Officer Kevin Tonn Memorial Highway signs that are now installed in Galt along Highway 99.

COMMISSION UPDATES

At their January 8, 2015 meeting, the Planning Commission elected Paul Sandhu as Chair and Leeann McFaddin as Vice Chair.

Staff and the City's consultant continue final edits on the City's new Development Code, which is expected to be presented to the Planning Commission at their February 12, 2015 meeting for recommendation to the City Council.

The Parks and Recreation commission elected Janice Reuthinger as Chair and Kelly Keagy as Vice Chair.

WEED CONTROL

Staff has begun bi-annual herbicide spraying to control weeds in Right-of-Ways and on City owned, or leased property. A new Ford F-250 is being outfitted with the palletized spray rig, which will augment the four wheel drive Gator. Staff has completed spraying around the Central Galt Interchange and the leased railroad property. Spraying will continue for the next few weeks.

SPORTS COMPLEX

Staff is beginning to prepare ball fields for the upcoming season. Infield mix has been ordered for delivery this week. Staff will implement the use of the new field groomer that was recently delivered.
