MEADOWVIEW AREA WATER SERVICE LINE REPLACEMENTS

The contractor exposed all of the water lateral service points and began replacing services on Tudor Street this past week. Lateral replacement work will continue on Tudor Street next week.

HARVEY PARK IMPROVEMENTS

All of the fence dugout and backstop work at the baseball field was completed in time for opening day on March 14. The fence around the Community Garden was completed this past week.

UPRR QUIET ZONE

Work has begun on the barrier fencing on the East side of the UPRR tracks, with the placement of the fence posts. Placement of the fencing panels will begin following fabrication and delivery, expected within the next 30 days.

STREETS AND STORMWATER NEWS

The new Tymco sweeper was delivered on Thursday, March 19. The current Tymco sweeper is seventeen years old. The average life expectancy for a sweeper is ten years. All major manufacturer's sweepers were demonstrated extensively and Tymco was ultimately chosen. We look forward to a similar experience with the new sweeper as we endeavor to provide excellent level of sweeping service, safe streets and keep pollutants out of the storm system.

COUNTRYSIDE PHASE 2 RESIDENTIAL SUBDIVISION

On March 12, the Planning Commission approved the architectural plan, floor plans and elevations, for the Countryside Phase 2 Residential Subdivision. Countryside is 14 unit subdivision located on Janine Court. The home builder for the subdivision is Bennet Homes.
