BUDGET WORKSHOP

A budget workshop is scheduled for Tuesday May 26 at 3:30 in the Galt City Council Chambers. Copies of the proposed Budget and Capital Improvement Program are available on the City's website.

TWIN CITIES ROAD ROUNDABOUTS PROJECT AWARD

The Construction Management Association of America (CMAA) Northern California Chapter holds an awards event each year to recognize excellence in Northern California projects--public works, transportation, programs and building projects in the public and private sector; along with recognition of owners, clients, construction management teams, architects, engineers, major partners and contractors.

Mayor Mark Crews and Public Works Director Steven Winkler attended the 2015 CMAA Awards ceremony on May 21, 2015 to accept a trophy for the Twin Cities Road Roundabouts Project presented to the City of Galt and Psomas, Omni-Means and George Reed, Inc. The project was selected as the top candidate in the transportation projects under \$10 million category.

SIMMERHORN-CARILLION WATER MAIN PROJECT

Due to equipment and materials scheduling, the contractor had to postpone the permanent trench re-paving along Simmerhorn Road and Carillion Boulevard. The paving is currently planned to start on May 26, 2015. Expect traffic control and delays along Simmerhorn Road and Carillion Boulevard next week.

GOLDEN HEIGHTS WATER TREATMENT PLANT PROJECT

The deep well and facility have been placed back into operation. The well and the new facility are performing as designed. In addition, a Notice of Completion has been issued.

ROBINSON FEED LOT ABATEMENT

Trash, clothes and the donation bin have been removed from the Robinsons Feed lot. Also, the weeds have been cut on the property. Staff continues to work with the property owner and railroad on abatement of the building. Weed abatement has been performed on two large pieces of vacant property in the City this past week: One located at the corner of Myrtle and Oak and the other at the corner of Lake Park and Carillion.

POLICE CORPORALS

The Police department announced the placement of the three Corporals. Effective Monday June 29, Corporal Small will be assigned to Investigations, Corporal Fisher to Patrol, and Corporal Azevedo to Patrol.
