CODE ENFORCEMENT UPDATE

Letters were sent out to 290 retail businesses in the City giving them information about the new temporary sign permit regulations. This was in addition to Code Enforcement going out to speak one on one with many of the businesses about signage. Starting on July 6, Code Enforcement has personally visited and spoke to the owners of over 60 businesses here in Galt regarding the new sign ordinance that will be coming into effect on July 17. The purpose of these meetings were for several different reasons ranging from getting to know the business owners, answering their questions about the sign ordinance and any other questions they may have regarding the municipal code. The City's Code Compliance Officer will continue to work with the business owners to ensure that the temporary sign regulations are complied with.

Code Enforcement partnered with Police, Parole, Narcotics and Probation officers to conduct a sweep of a few problem areas in the Meadowview neighborhood. Citations were issued and compliance dates have been set.

WWTP REPORT OF WASTE DISCHARGE APPLICATION

On July 14, 2015, the Regional Water Quality Control Board provided the City with an administrative draft version of the City's new permit. Staff will review and provide Council with a brief report outlining key permit provisions that are proposed.
