WATER METER PROJECT

Global Fathom continues water meter installations at properties with obstructions (concrete driveways, planter boxes, etc.). Approximately 350 meters remain to be installed within the next six weeks.

EMERALD PARK SUBDIVISION

Installation of underground utilities continued this past week for the 25 lot Emerald Park subdivision, located on the East side of Highway 99 South of Walnut Avenue.

SPHERE OF INFLUENCE OPEN HOUSE

An Open House has been scheduled for the property owners and registered voters living in the areas of the City's sphere of influence that the City is considering annexing as part of an expansion of the industrial park and around the Twin Cities Road/Highway 99 interchange. Based on the reaction received from the Open House attendees, staff will fine-tune the annexation area boundaries and report back to the City Council with the results.

RESIDENTIAL GAS LEAK
