HARVEY PARK BATHROOM PROJECT

Council approved the Harvey Park Bathroom Project award on Tuesday, September 15. A contract has been sent to CXT, Inc. for execution and delivery of the prefabricated bathroom is expected within the next 90 days, with installation to be completed within two to three weeks thereafter.

COMMUNITY CLEAN-UP DAY

The Police Department coordinated a community clean-up day along Dry Creek on Saturday, September 12. The event was a great success; approximately 25 volunteers from the community assisted several members of the Police Department and Public Works. Mercy Housing also assisted over the past several weeks. With everyone working together, two large construction dumpsters were filled with trash and illegal camp materials left behind by illegal campers. Approximately 60 cubic feet of material was collected, weighing approximately 6 tons according to Cal-Waste. The bright spot of the day was when the group met with and helped move the personal belonging of two campers who had found a home nearby and were no longer homeless.
