ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT MANAGER

The City has hired a part time Economic Development Manager, Amie Mendes, who will begin work in late October. The Economic Development Manager will work closely with other City departments to ensure business development and growth is actively promoted in the City; work to implement the City's Comprehensive Economic Development Strategy, help build and strengthen existing businesses, and endeavor to attract new businesses to the City.

ROAD CLOSURES FOR THE RAILROAD QUIET ZONE

The Railroad Quiet Zone improvements are scheduled to resume next week. The construction involves improvements at the Elm, F, C, A and Kost railroad crossings. Road closures for A, C and F Street between 3rd and 4th Streets are tentatively scheduled for:

A Street	9/28 – 10/1
C Street	10/5 – 10/8
F Street	10/12 – 10/15

Work at Elm and Kost will be subject to one-lane traffic controls, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. A full schedule of road closures can be found on the City of Galt website home page.

ETCH & CATCH EVENT

The Galt Police Department, in conjunction with Jiffy Lube, State Farm Insurance and Raley's, held an "Etch & Catch" event by which citizens could have their catalytic converters etched with their vehicle license plate number. The presence of a license plate number on catalytic converters can provide police with the information needed to identify stolen property, contact victims, and apprehend and prosecute criminals.
