

## CITY MANAGER'S WEEKLY UPDATE

October 15, 2015

### **WATER CONSERVATION**

The Water Conservation Officers continue to educate residents to the Stage 3 water conservation requirements. They made 171 verbal and written customer contacts during the month of September.

### **CREEKSIDE 3**

Grading of the Creekside 3 subdivision, on the north side of Kost Road and between S. Lincoln Way and Joy Drive will commence shortly. Improvements for Joy Drive will also be commencing which will result in a temporary road closure. Alternative access to the Galt Cemetery will be provided while the road is being reconstructed.

### **EMERALD PARK UNIT 22**

Curb, gutter and sidewalks improvements are continuing this week with paving of the streets to follow. The Emerald Park Unit 22 developer will be constructing a pedestrian bridge across Deadmans Gulch and modifying the existing trail that goes into Emerald Vista Park and runs east to Canyon Creek Park. Portions of the trail will need to be closed during construction, which could start as early as next week. The contractor will be placing informational signage in advance of the closure.

The Railroad Quiet Zone Safety improvements on F Street are substantially complete. CDM Smith is in the process of preparing the Notice of Establishment for the Quiet Zone. In support of this effort City staff will be providing CDM with updated traffic counts next week. It is anticipated that the Quiet Zone will be formally approved and enacted within 60 days.
