**UPRR TRACK MAINTENANCE**

UPRR is currently staging for major track maintenance work, which will begin in the next couple weeks. This will include rolling road closures at the Kost Road, F Street, C Street, A Street and Elm Avenue crossings.

**QUIET ZONE**

Final quiet zone approval is being reviewed by the various agencies involved (UPRR, Federal Railroad Administration, California Public Utilities Commission and Amtrak). Site inspection of the crossing improvements by UPRR is scheduled within the next week and final approval is anticipated in the next month.

**EASTVIEW ANNEXATION AND SPECIFIC PLAN PROJECT**

After a series of public hearings, the Planning Commission recommended approval of the Eastview annexation and Specific Plan project, with modifications, to the City Council. Staff anticipates bringing the project before Council in the near future.

**HARVEY PARK RENOVATION PROJECT**

The Harvey Park Restroom project has commenced and the demolition of the dilapidated restrooms is underway. **RECYCLING CONTAINERS AT COMMUNITY PARK**  
Staff installed two new in-ground recycle material containers at the Community Park. The containers were purchased using recycling grant funds from CalRecycle.

**SPRING CLEANING**

With spring around the corner, park staff is busy preparing the landscape areas around the City by mulching landscape areas, pruning, removing weeds and many other beautification projects.
