RAILROAD QUIET ZONE

This week the Quiet Zone for the City of Galt was officially approved for the Elm Avenue, A Street, C Street, F Street and Kost Road Railroad crossings. The Quiet Zone, while established, may take the locomotive engineers a couple of weeks to consistently not blow their horns. Even after the Quiet Zone is fully implemented, locomotive engineers will still blow their horns when safety issues are perceived.

SMUD CONSTRUCTION

SMUD will be doing electric utility work in the Cloverfield neighborhood starting on Monday, March 28th. There will be intermittent traffic controls and lane closures on West Elm Ave/Orr Road, Ashley Way, Sunshine Drive, Oberlin Way and Rossi Drive over the next couple of weeks.
