### DEVELOPMENT UPDATE

- The Planning Commission approved the Arco AM/PM and Starbucks Project at its meeting on May 12, 2016. The project includes a 2,200 square foot Starbucks coffee house with drive through, an 8 pump (16 hose) Arco gas station and a 3,171 square foot AM/PM convenience store. The site is located at 12821 east Stockton Boulevard – directly south of the new McDonald's on Twin Cities Road.
- H&R Block submitted an application for a Tenant Improvement (TI) building permit for a branch location at 10400 Twin Cities Road, Suite 30, in the Galt Village Center (Raley's shopping center and are now in plan check.
- BMD submitted an application for a building permit for a 12,000 square foot warehouse addition and are now in plan check.
- Bennett Homes (Countryside Unit 2 subdivision) submitted 3 permits for new single family home and are now in plan check.
- A TI building permit was submitted for a dentist office expansion and new hair salon at 216 N Lincoln Way and are now in plan check.

Freeway Frida was rescued by Officers Hill and Coelho, with the help of CHP, and is recovering nicely. Bradshaw Veterinary's expert staff is taking great care of her.
