PROPOSED OPERATING AND CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM BUDGETS

The Operating Budget for FY 16-18 and the Capital Improvement Program Budget for FY 16-21 are in the final stages of completion and will be presented at the City Council meeting on Tuesday, June 7, 2016, at 7:00 p.m.

- Tenant improvement building permits have been issued for a dentist office expansion and a new hair salon 216 Lincoln Way.
- A building permit is ready to be issued for the Carillon Corners Shopping Center Building B (Rite Aid Center). The building will be home to a Taco Bell and Squeeze Inn Restaurant.

Residential:

- Six Single Family Dwelling homes have been scheduled for final inspection at River Oaks 3 - Elliott Homes.
- Three permits have been issued for new single family homes at the Countryside Unit 2 subdivision - Bennett Homes
