PROPOSED OPERATING AND CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM BUDGETS

The Operating Budget for FY 16-18 and the Capital Improvement Program Budget for FY 16-21 was approved at the City Council meeting on Tuesday, June 7.

RAILROAD CROSSING UPGRADES PROJECT

Union Pacific Railroad will be upgrading all five roadway crossings in the city limits, from Elm Avenue to Kost Road over the next 8 weeks. The last time the crossings were upgraded was in 2006. The crossings settle over time and the upgrades will provide a smoother and safer crossing for traffic. Work is scheduled to begin at Elm Avenue on Monday, June 20. Each crossing will be completely closed for a period of 3 to 5 days. Advance notice signs will be placed to warn motorists of pending closures. Detours will be available.

SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICERS

The Police Department has experienced great success with the Juvenile Diversion Program implemented and managed by School Resource Officer, Sylvia Coelho. The statistics are as follows: 2013 - 7 participants with 6 successfully completing the program; 2014 - 11 participants with 10 successfully completing the program; 2015 - 9 participants with all successfully completing the program; 2016 - 7 participants. In the past two weeks, 6 have successfully completed the program and the 7th is on target for successful completion.
