UPRR PROJECT UPDATE

Anticipated re-opening of A Street is Friday, July 15th. The next scheduled crossing to be upgraded is C Street, which is scheduled to commence on Monday, July 18th. C Street will be closed for approximately 9 days to allow completion of the work.

LITTLETON STOVES

Delivery of the new stoves for the Littleton Center kitchen is expected next week, with final set-up to follow receipt. If all goes well, the new stoves should be available for use by July 25th.

GOLDEN HEIGHTS WATER TREATMENT PLANT

The new Golden Heights deep well suffered a motor failure this past week, taking the City's lead well out of service. Other City wells are being used to offset the loss of the Golden Heights Well, pending the completion of warranty repairs at the contractor's expense.

WWTP UPGRADE STATUS

Upgrades to the Wastewater Treatment Plant internal water systems are nearly completed. The in-plant recycle water pumps have been installed and are scheduled for testing next week. A new variable frequency drive (VFD) control system has been installed on the supply well. The expanded Utilities Operation Building is nearing completion. It is anticipated that staff will be able to occupy the building in the next several weeks.

- The Galt Gators finished the final dual meet this past weekend with a meet against Rollingwood. The final score was Galt 559.5 v. Rollingwood 261.5. **The Gators have completed the dual meet season undefeated for the Eureka Conference.**
- Three records were broken at this meet:

 - *Gavin Weaver, Caleb Stewart, Aaron Hicks and Joseph Lopez – 13/14 boys 200 yard medley relay – 1:36.64 New Eureka Conference Record*
- Eureka Conference Championships will be held in Woodland July 23-24. As of this morning, we have 137 swimmers registered to participate.
