UPRR PROJECT UPDATE

The paving of A Street is tentatively scheduled for Wednesday, July 12, dependent upon the Union Pacific Railroad maintaining its current schedule. Paving may take two days. Anticipated re-opening of A Street will be July 13.

The next scheduled overcrossing upgrade is C Street. We are currently scheduling the closure for 8:00 a.m., Monday, July 18. Union Pacific should be finished with their portion of the upgrade by July 25. Tentative paving date is July 26 and may also take two days.

All dates are dependent upon there being no unexpected delays. Updates will be provided as they become available.

CREEKSIDE UNIT 3 (KOST ROAD AND LINCOLN WAY)

The developer continues to complete required public infrastructure. This past week paving and road widening was accomplished along the Kost Road and Lincoln Way frontages, along with the final paving on Joy Drive. Look for construction traffic controls and anticipate delays.

LITTLETON STOVE REPLACEMENT

A purchase order was issued for the stoves last week, Vulcan (the manufacturer) has indicated the units will ship on July 12, with delivery by July 21. Installation will occur following receipt (minor electrical connections).
