

**CITY MANAGER'S WEEKLY UPDATE**  
**August 12, 2016**

**BIKE/PED PATH REPAIR**

Staff has completed patch paving along the walking path on the south side of Walnut Avenue. Initial removal of trip hazards occurred last fall, but final paving was delayed by inclement weather and competing work priorities.

**UPRR UPDATE**

Work on the final crossing, at Kost Road, will begin on Monday, August 15. Paving should be completed on the 17<sup>th</sup>. Kost Road will be closed to through traffic from August 15 to August 18. Detours will be posted.

**PATCH PAVING**

Staff has begun patch paving Citywide, to remove temporary cold mix asphalt in areas that were excavated to repair/replace water and sewer laterals. This work will continue, as scheduling permits, through the remainder of the summer. Staff is also doing patch paving in the Market grounds on areas that are failing. This work can only be done on Thursdays and Fridays. Staff has spent one day paving at the Market and plan to spend a few more days to complete the repair of failing areas.

**SACRAMENTO TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY - MEASURE B UPDATE**

Jeff Spencer, STA Executive Director, will be the featured speaker at the August 18<sup>th</sup> Chamber of Commerce luncheon scheduled for August 18 at Wholey Ravioli. Mr. Spencer will be presenting information about the "Measure B" ballot initiative, proposing a supplemental ½ cent transportation sales tax.

**CREEKSIDE- UNIT NO.3**

The raised center island and interim striping have been completed on Lincoln Way. Work continues on frontage landscaping and placement of streetlights.

**C STREET/CENTRAL GALT COMPLETE STREET PROJECT**

This project is currently out to bid with responses due on August 18. This federally funded project will entail major roadwork and frontage improvements along the C Street corridor from Lincoln Way to Sixth Street; and along the Fourth Street corridor from B Street to F Street. In addition to pavement rehabilitation work, enhanced sidewalks, landscaping and diagonal parking will be installed along the west side of Fourth Street; decorative crosswalks will be installed at most intersections. Bulb-outs will be placed at intersections along C Street for traffic calming, along with sidewalk & landscaping improvements along C Street. Several decorative monuments will be included highlighting the 'Old Town' and water tower themes.
