

**CITY MANAGER'S WEEKLY UPDATE**

**UPRR PROJECT**

While work within the city limits is complete, work outside the city limits continues. UPRR has tentatively scheduled the crossing upgrade on Twin Cities Road for the week of Sept 19. They anticipate the work to last five to seven days. There will be traffic control and detours available. Spring Street will be utilized as the alternate route. The schedule is subject to change and updates will be provided as additional information is forwarded by county staff.

**PATCH PAVING**

Citywide patch paving continues as crews replace temporary asphalt that was placed after underground utility work, with permanent hot mix asphalt. Additionally, pavement repairs in the Market grounds is continuing on Thursdays.
