WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT UPGRADES

Reconstruction of the main access road to the WWTP and firing ranges is underway. Access is being provided via detour along an alternative access road to the west.

DRY CREEK OAKS SUBDIVISION (Boessow Road at Crystal Way)

Significant site grading continues. Hydrant permits have been issued for construction water needed for dust control and compaction purposes, with fees paid for the water being used.

CREEKSIDE UNIT 3 (Parker Creek II)

All public improvements are now substantially complete, with only minor 'punch list' items remaining.
