**Section 6.04.010 Adoption.**

The board of supervisors of the county has heretofore adopted an ordinance providing for the control of animals, licensing of dogs, providing for the collection of fees, impounding of animals, and similar matters, and that Ordinance 1053 is incorporated and adopted by reference, three certified copies of the same being on file in the office of the city clerk. (Ord. 147 § 1, 1970: Ord. 125 § 1, 1967: prior code § 3000 (part))

**Section 6.04.020 Applicability.**

Under the provisions of Section 30501 of the Food and Agricultural Code of the state, the provisions of Ordinance No. 1053 shall apply throughout any city located in the county whenever the governing body of the city by ordinance requests the application thereof within the confines of the city, and it is deemed to be to the best interests of the city that it request the application of the provisions of said ordinance code sections within the confines of the city. **Section 6.04.030 Fees paid to and retained by county.**

All fees referred to in this chapter or in the ordinance code sections adopted by reference in this chapter shall be paid to and retained by the county. (Ord. 125 § 5, 1967)

**Section 6.04.040 Enforcement.**

It is requested of the board of supervisors of the county that the provisions of Ordinance No. 1053 and the provisions of the sections of the Food and Agricultural Code of the state therein adopted as set forth in Section 30501, apply throughout the city, that the city clerk forward a certified copy of the ordinance codified in this chapter to the board of supervisors of the county, and that the mayor and the city clerk be authorized and instructed to execute an animal control agreement setting forth the terms and conditions for the enforcement of this chapter.
