##### Drug Take Back Day

The Galt Police Department will again partner with the Drug Enforcement Administration for the 13<sup>th</sup> National Prescription Drug Take Back Day. Medications no longer needed, have expired, or otherwise require disposal can be taken to our collection site at the Galt Police Department on Saturday, April 29, 2017, from 10:00 am to 2:00 pm. Drug Take Back Day aims to provide a safe, convenient, and ecologically responsible method of prescription drug disposal while also educating the public about the potential for abuse of medications.

##### Formation of Groundwater Sustainability Agency

A public hearing will be conducted as part of the May 2 council meeting to consider establishing the City of Galt as a Groundwater Sustainability Agency (GSA) for that portion of the Cosumnes Subbasin underlying the city limits of Galt. ##### 4<sup>th</sup> Street Improvements Update

The contractor will begin site preparation work next week on 4th Street, between A and F Streets. Preparation work includes clearing and saw-cutting affected areas, protecting existing trees, and locating utilities.
