South Galt Safe Routes to School and Rehabilitation and SACOG Bicycle and Pedestrian Project

The project has been advertised, with bids due on September 21. This \$6.3 million project will install pedestrian and bicycle improvements along various streets south of Pringle Avenue and west of Highway 99. This will include new and upgraded bike lanes, sidewalk repairs and new sidewalks at select locations providing access to schools, and roadway rehabilitation on Lincoln Way and A Street. Construction is tentatively scheduled for the spring of 2018.
