POLICE DEPARTMENT

PUBLIC WORKS

River Oaks 3-Carillion Blvd Construction

Construction is beginning on modifications to the Carillion Boulevard median from the railroad tracks north about 600 feet. In addition, the accessible ramps on the west side of the Carillion Boulevard/Vintage Oak Avenue/Ambrogio Way intersection will be upgraded. There will be lane closures and traffic controls during the one month construction period.

Fourth Street Complete Streets Project

Placement of a 12' wide all-weather surface for vendor access, along the back of the 'Promenade' sidewalk (north of C Street), and a 40' wide all-weather overflow parking surface adjacent to the new parking lot (south of C street) will commence in mid-October. Street lights are tentatively scheduled for installation during this same time frame.
