Clean-out those closets, garages and clean-up your yards . . . Galt Clean-Up Day is just around the corner. On April 25th, from 9am-2pm at the Galt Market grounds, Galt citizens can dispose of yard and garden waste, hazardous waste, furniture, tires, appliances, etc. free of charge.

This year as in past years, the City will be accepting hazardous waste which includes paint, batteries, TV's, fertilizers, computer monitors, household cleaners and propane tanks. **All hazardous waste must be dumped before continuing to the main dumping stations.** Explosives, biomedical and radioactive waste will not be accepted.

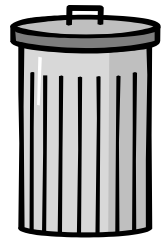
Tips for safe transport of hazardous waste include insuring all caps are tightly secured, stand items in boxes or other containers to prevent spillage and box like products together.

Senior citizens can contact the City Clerk's office (366-7130) to schedule a pick-up. Items must be bagged, bundled or boxed and be placed in the driveway. There is a limit of one truck-load per home for pick-ups.

Each month citizens pay 70 cents on their garbage bill to finance the event therefore, participants **MUST** live within the Galt City limits. Participants must bring a City utility bill or a California Driver's License or ID card. Residents of unincorporated Sacramento County may call (916) 363-9390 for

information on County Household Hazardous Waste events. No business or industrial waste is permitted.

City staff will volunteer their time while parks and recreation and public works employees will be on duty to work the waste removal event. This year the South Valley United Cheer Assoc. will sell coffee and donuts in the morning and hot dogs, chips and sodas in the afternoon.



So, clean out your closets, yards, sheds, garages, etc. and take advantage of this event.

## OPENING OF NEW STORAGE RESERVOIR



The City recently completed construction of the Industrial Park Pump Station, located at the southwest corner of Live Oak Avenue at the Union Pacific Railroad tracks at a cost of \$2.3 million. Two 1.5 million gallon water storage reservoirs and a pump station were constructed as a part of this project. The purpose of this station is to increase the amount of total water storage and to provide better regulation of pressure in the older areas of the City. The City now has the capacity to store 9 million gallons of water. The second purpose of the station is to provide fire flows necessary for the Industrial Park Area. The pump station is capable of providing over 4,000 gallons of water per minute, allowing the Fire District to do their job in an emergency.
