

CITY MANAGER'S WEEKLY UPDATE

CRACK SEALING

Staff will begin fall roadway crack sealing the week of November 26 and continue into the middle of December, weather permitting.

VEGETATION CONTROL

Recent rains have resulted in vegetation growth in City right-of ways and open space. Staff will be performing vegetation control in various areas citywide over the next two weeks, as weather permits.

CENTRAL GALT INTERCHANGE

Fairway Drive and the southbound Hwy 99 on-ramp are now open to traffic, using temporary stop signs. Opening of the "C" Street over-crossing is anticipated in the next week, with full signal operation expected the following week.

PAL MEETING

Councilmember Singleton, Lt. Vizzusi, Chief Bowen, and Bridget Berlin (Director of the Galt High School Century 21 Grant) attended a meeting Tuesday with the Elk Grove Police Athletic League Director. Elk Grove offered their assistance and suggestions on possibly starting a PAL program in Galt.

PINE STREET MCDONALDS RENOVATION

The permit has been issued and they will begin construction on November 16, with an estimated 6 week construction schedule. Improvements include removal of the playground area, installation of a double lane drive through and updated building facade.
