

## CITY MANAGER'S WEEKLY UPDATE

January 10, 2013

### **SEARCH WARRANT**

Officers and detectives, in conjunction with the Department of Justice, served a search warrant involving internet gambling at Lucky Internet Café, 905 C Street after a three month undercover investigation. Computers, surveillance equipment and cash were confiscated. One of the business co-owners was arrested. An arrest warrant for the other owner is being sought through the District Attorney's office.

### **CENTRAL GALT INTERCHANGE**

Caltrans testing of the traffic signal detector loops, wiring and controllers is underway. It is anticipated the signals will be fully operational within the next week. Teichert is working on completion of final 'Punch List' items.

### **KOST WELL & WATER TREATMENT PLANT**

The City's State Revolving Fund (SRF Low Interest Loan Application) for planning and design has been deemed complete. The SRF Loan will provide initial project funding (\$376,000) for design of a new 'Deep Well' and water treatment plant to enhance city water supplies and allow elimination of older wells with elevated arsenic levels. State review of the technical, financial, and environmental aspects of the project is now underway as the next step in the process to obtain a funding agreement.

### **LIVE OAK PUMP STATION AND FORCE MAIN**

Excavation of the future pump station site, on Live Oak Avenue, is underway.
