### **OFFICER TONN'S FUNERAL**

City employees and Council attended the memorial service for Officer Kevin Tonn on Monday. The services were a fitting tribute to the life and service of a dedicated officer who made the ultimate sacrifice in protecting our great community.

### **STRATEGIC PLANNING MEETING**

Management staff and the City Council held a day long workshop to review and update the City's Strategic Plan. The Strategic Plan is an important planning document to set priorities and direction for the City.

### **APPLICATION SUBMITTED FOR NEW MCDONALD'S RESTAURANT**

A site plan review application was submitted for development of a second McDonald's restaurant at the southeast corner of East Stockton Boulevard and Twin Cities Road, at the location of the former gas station. Planning staff has initiated its review and will distribute it for public agency/department review this week.

### **PUBLIC, EDUCATION, GOVERNMENT (PEG) FACILITIES AND EQUIPMENT GRANT**

Public Works staff is soliciting quotes for facility improvements at City Hall for the media control room and Council Chamber improvements that are funded by Public, Education, and Government (PEG) Facilities and Equipment fees collected from local cable companies by Sac Metro Cable. The funding is to provide improved video capabilities and aesthetics for on-line and televised events.

### **CAPS OPEN HOUSE**

The Police Department held an Open House for the CAPS volunteer program this week. The response was impressive with 35 interest cards and/or applications submitted.

### **MEASURE R**

The Measure R Oversight Committee met Wednesday evening and discussed the FY 2011/12 year end audit and the annual presentation to council. The Measure R Oversight Committee plans to present the annual report at the March 5 meeting.
